- Willingness to be hands on in serving children, families and team
- Someone passionate about contributing to the life of Kings Church as a whole
- There is a genuine occupational requirement that the post-holder be a practising Christian; passionate about the worship of Jesus Christ, and will be part of the family of King's Church Birmingham

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE ROLE

- To carry heart and vision, and champion the key priority of Kids, Youth and Families work in all relevant areas of church life
- To regularly pray for Kings Church Kids, Youth and families
- To ensure the smooth running of Kids and Youth work on Sundays
- To help oversee and plan Kids and Youth events, or the relevant aspects of wider church events
- To oversee Child safeguarding (training provided)
- To attend the weekly staff Tactical meeting
- To oversee recruitment to Kids and Youth teams
- To train, envision and encourage Kids Team Leaders and teams
- To plan and develop various aspects of teaching and discipleship
- To plan the programme of events and hold the budget each year
- To help plan and/or lead family Sundays i.e., Carols, Dedications, Baptisms
- To develop future family focussed ministries in line with church vision and growth

HOURS OF WORK: 16-20 hours per week including Sunday mornings (these hours are flexible for discussion with the successful candidate including the possibility of term time working.)
